**August 1, 2015**: Brave Spirits Theater, the Washington DC Metropolitan area's premiere producer of little-known early modern plays, is proud to announce an encore production of its highly acclaimed Fringe production of Thomas Middleton's *The Bloody Banquet*, returning to the Anacostia Arts Center August 20<sup>th</sup> through 22<sup>nd</sup>.
